Major Lawrence R. Wilson's is an expert in the area of Strategic Business Consulting. He is regarded as the longest serving staff officer in the region and has held various positions during his career, including Colour Ensign, Aide and was finally appointed as the first Command Staff Officer (Command Adjutant) of the force in 2008. He was responsible for coordinating the administrative and logistical planning for the entire force and concurrently served as secretary on the Ministry of National Security Advisory Committee -TTCF. Major Wilson was a member of the national secretariats for the 2009 Commonwealth Heads of Government meeting and the Fifth Summit of the Americas. He was also a member of the Cabinet Appointed Committee (Ministry of National Security) for TTCF's 100th Anniversary Committee.

Major Wilson's military and civilian awards and decorations include; Fifth Summit of the Americas – (Service Medal), Caribbean Cadet Medal (CCM), Cadet Force Medal (CFM) for Long and Meritorious Service. He also received the Commandant's Efficiency Award (CEA). He was a recipient of the National Youth Development Award – (Technical and Vocational Education) in 1988, and National Youth Development Award – (Gold medal for Community Service) in 1987.

He also received the Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards from the President's Award Programme of Trinidad and Tobago (PAPTI) and was a recipient of a Gold Medallion, presented by His Excellency Prince Edward Earl of Wessex in 1990.

Major Wilson has substantial experience in the educational sector, as he is a past member of the National Examinations Council of Trinidad and Tobago and a former lecturer at John S. Donaldson Technical Institute and the Youth Training and Employment Partnership Program (YTEPP). He spent over seventeen (17) years lecturing, subsequent to attaining his wireman's licenses for electrical installation for industrial, commercial and domestic buildings. Major Wilson has served on several boards including; Eshe's Learning Centre, the Caribbean Carnival Commission and is an advisory board member of the Global Chamber and a sporting organization.
